Group Project

For this assignment your group will create and present a PowerPoint or Prezi presentation sharing your research on a violation of human rights that might be considered a genocide.

Your presentation should consist of no more than EIGHT slides or elements in which you:

- identify the event (description);
- provide historical context (analysis--how did the event get to the point that atrocities occurred?);
- locate and analyze a primary source from the event (describe it & explain how it contributes to our knowledge of the event);
- explain why or why not this event should be considered a genocide (based on the United Nations definition);
- include a bibliography in Chicago Manual of Style (CMS) author-date format (the bibliography does not count as part of your eight slides).

Approved sources for your research are those available through the library's webpage (http://www.westminster.edu/academics/library/index.cfm): electronic encyclopedias and online reference sources, online or print journals, and books or e-books found in the online catalog.

All sources used in your presentation should be cited. You may not cite Wikipedia in your presentation.

Your presentation should last no more than TEN minutes. Be prepared to answer questions and address comments from your classmates.

You will present on May 3 or 5. Upload your PowerPoint (or a note that you are doing a Prezi) by 11:55 p.m. May 2.

This assignment is worth 20% of your course grade.
